Easter does not just celebrate that Christ is risen; it proclaims that we are being made new, together. So the question before us is not only what we believe, but how we will live:

- How will we participate in the life of this church?
- How will we support and sustain the ministry we share?
- How will we open ourselves to discovering God anew in this season?

As we continue this journey toward Easter and beyond, may we walk the road together with courage, generosity, and trust, confident that the God who has led us this far is not finished with us yet.

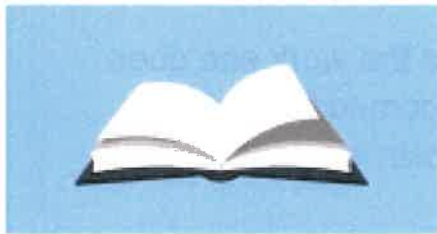
