DEAR SPRING HILL PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH FAMILY,

The Session of SHPC has voted to move forward with our congregation's multi-step plan for returning by transitioning into **Step 2**. (You can find the entire plan on our church website and Facebook page.) This decision means that we will continue to conduct our primary Sunday morning worship service and many other gatherings online, however, we will also begin to utilize outdoor spaces at the church for supplemental worship and other church actives. On June 28 at 7:00 PM we will gather for our first Sunday Evening Vespers Service, which will be entirely outdoors and will follow social distancing and other health protocols. Andrew and Bryan Ayers will provide music for this special time of prayer and fellowship, and future weeks will involve other musicians in the church such as Brandon Rice and Bill Oppenheimer. Everyone is encouraged to bring your own folding chairs, picnic blankets, or beach towels to sit on. Some parking spaces will be available for those who need to stay in their cars. Anyone in a high-risk category should stay home from these services. Church groups such as Supper Clubs, PW Circles, Yeomen, Sunday School classes, or any other groups are encouraged to think creatively about safe ways that you may be able to gather outside and be together. Please communicate those plans with the church so that they can be carefully coordinated. If the rate of infection in our area takes a significant turn for the worse, the Coronavirus Commission at the church may alter these plans to keep all of our members and our community safe.
