Dear Saints of Spring Hill Presbyterian Church,

As we enter the season of Lent, we are invited to embark on a sacred journey—a time of reflection, renewal, and deepening our relationship with God. Lent is a season of letting go of the things that separate us from God and embracing spiritual practices that draw us closer to God's presence in our lives. It is a season of intentional discipleship, of walking with Christ toward the cross, and ultimately, toward the joy of resurrection on Easter morning.

Ash Wednesday: Marking the Beginning

Our journey begins on Ash Wednesday, March 5, with two services at **noon and 5:30 PM** in the chapel. Each service will include Holy Communion and the imposition of ashes, marking us with a visible sign of our mortality and our dependence on God's grace. This ancient practice reminds us that our lives are not our own—we belong to God.

Keeping a Holy Lent Together

Lent is not just about what we give up—it is about what we take on. As individuals, as table groups, and as a whole church, we are called to keep a holy Lent by engaging in spiritual practices that deepen our faith. Whether through daily prayer, acts of service, scripture reading, fasting, or table fellowship, let us encourage one another in this season of growth.

Meeting Jesus at the Table: A Church-Wide Lenten Study

One way we will keep a holy Lent together is through a church-wide study of *Meeting Jesus at the Table*. Throughout scripture, Jesus shares meals with his followers, teaching, healing, and welcoming all to God's table. This study will invite us to reflect on how Christ's table shapes our identity as his disciples and how we are called to extend that welcome to others.

There are several ways to participate, making it easy for everyone to engage:

• **Wednesdays at Noon**—Following our weekly communion service, everyone is welcome to come around the table and enjoy lunch. Those who wish to reflect can gather over lunch for small group discussions. Whether you join a table group or simply come for worship and lunch, these gatherings will be a time of fellowship, reflection, and spiritual renewal.

• Sundays at 9:00 AM – An ongoing study will take place in the Fellowship Hall before worship.

• Home Groups Throughout the Week – Members are encouraged to host or join a home group at a time that works best for them. You can sign up for an official small group or form your own group with friends, family, or neighbors.

An Invitation to the Journey

Lent is not a solitary path—it is a journey we take together, supporting one another as we seek to grow in faith and discipleship. I invite you to commit to this season with intention and to walk with us as we prepare our hearts for the joy of Easter morning.

May this Lent be a time of renewal for each of us, for our table groups, and for our church as a whole. May we discover anew the depth of God's love and the power of Christ's resurrection in our lives.

Meeting Jesus at the Table Schedule for 6-Week Lenten Study

There are three ways in which to participate in a weekly table discussion around chapters of the book, *Meeting Jesus at the Table*:

- 1. Following our noon Lenten Worship service in the chapel on Wednesdays. Lunch and table conversations in Fellowship Hall.
- 2. From 9:00-10:00 in Fellowship Hall on Sunday mornings, with breakfast snacks.
- 3. In small groups with a designated Host at a day/time TBD.

Assigned chapters for discussion of *Meeting Jesus at the Table:*

Week 1, Introduction and Chapter 1 – March 5 or 9, or with a small group

Week 2, Chapter 2 – March 12 or 16, or with a small group

Week 3, Chapter 3 – March 19 or 23, or with a small group

Week 4, Chapters 4 and 5 – March 26 or 30, or with a small group

Week 5, Chapter 6 – April 2 or 6, or with a small group

Week 6, Chapters 7 and 8 – April 9 or 13, (Chapter 7 aligns with Maundy Thursday. Chapter 8 aligns with Easter.)


